**2018 WINTER NET SET GO & JUNIOR NETBALL SEASON**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Welcome old and new students and families to St Peter's Netball 2018. St Peter's compete as part of the Noranda Netball Association at Noranda Netball Centre, Garson Court, Noranda. If you've been keeping up with Netball WA, you may have heard about the new changes to NetSetGo for 2018.

From 2018 onwards NetSetGo will be organized into three separate tiers: Net, Set, and Go. The tiers will be separated by age, and St Peter teams will participate in the Set, Go and Junior divisions only and will be based on schooling year. On occasion, depending on numbers, a team may consist of players from two school year groups. Our teams are made up of 8-9 players competing in:

-  SET GO - Years 3 participate in SET, and Year 4 and 5 students participate in GO.
-  JUNIOR – Year 6 students.

All games will be in the morning time slot with Set GO starting at 8.45am and Netball starting at 10.00am. On occasion some Set Go and Netball games will be played at 10.00am and 11.30am respectively. The season begins on Saturday May 5<sup>th</sup> and ends in August with finals in September.

### **TEAM ORGANISATION**

This year for the first time St Peters netball teams in Year 3, 4 and 5 in the new SET and GO divisions will be organized by year group, using a transparent non-graded process. In line with St Peters values; Trust, Respect, Unity and Excellence the committee will invite the St Peters Administration team to assist with this process. This will take the form of names being drawn from a hat to decide team placement. We hope this new selection process will encourage participation by new players, a chance to make new friends and opportunities to develop skills and participate in a fantastic sport.

St Peters teams in the JUNIOR division will include Year 6 team/s only. As in past seasons Year 6 players will participate in a grading session which is **COMPULSORY**. In the event that your child is unable to attend the session they will be graded as not attending in order to ensure an equitable and transparent process.

We have been fortunate in the past to have a number of parents and ex-St Peter's students assist us with umpiring. Umpires must have a sound understanding of the rules and confidence on the court.

New umpires are encouraged to participate in the Noranda Umpiring Squad Course held by Noranda Netball Association.

### **COACHES & ASSISTANT COACHES**

Coaching is voluntary, if you are interested in coaching or know someone who may be interested, please **nominate your interest by contacting Ellen McAllister 0421 402 470 as soon as possible** or by emailing the committee. We have been fortunate in the past to have a number of parents and high school students take on this role and they have done a fantastic job. Parent participation is essential and the committee will not be able to register a team where a coach cannot be arranged. St Peters Netball Committee are hoping to book a NetSetGo and Junior Coach Education session presented by Netball WA before the season commences, so please see the newsletter for updates.

During the season, parents not happy with a coach's or umpire's decision and ruling, are not to approach them, please see a committee member to discuss the matter or dispute. **PLEASE REMEMBER COACHES AND UMPIRES ARE VOLUNTEERS**. If you are continually unhappy with their decision or actions – volunteer to assist.

## TEAM MANAGERS

The role of the Team Manager is to help in keeping the team organized. They will:

- 🏆 Look after the team equipment.
- 🏆 Bibs are kept in good order and returned at the end of each game (a simple airing of bibs with occasional washes will help keep elastics from fraying and becoming too loose).
- 🏆 Game ball is inflated and ready for each game.
- 🏆 Orange & Scoring rosters for parents.
- 🏆 Distribution of any notes to the players/parents.
- 🏆 Collection & Distribution of money to umpires each week.
- 🏆 Assist with end of season wind up and assist the Committee for Trophy Presentation.
- 🏆 Return equipment at the end of the season.

## TRAINING AND SATURDAY GAMES

Training days and times are decided by the coach's availability. If not their usual sports day, players are required to bring a change of clothes (shorts, t-shirt, sand shoes), water bottle and a snack. We ask that siblings are not left while training is on, due to Duty of Care.

Training is compulsory and all players are expected to attend unless for a legitimate reason. It is important for all players to commit to training as coaches have given up their time to help train. Parent assistance is also appreciated and encouraged.

If you are unable to train or participate in a Saturday game please contact your coach ASAP.

Training venue is yet to be confirmed; hopefully the school court is available for training this season.

## UNIFORMS

There is a strict dress code for Noranda Netball Association and correct uniform is expected. St Peters has received advise that schools must be play in school uniform as per Noranda Netball Constitution. St Peter's have registered the following uniform:

## CODE OF CONDUCT

St Peter's Netball is committed to good sportsmanship and playing guidelines – please make yourself familiar with these guidelines and explain in detail to your child what is expected of them. Additionally, explain to your child the commitment required to team sports and the team attitudes required.

Once you have read through the Code of Conduct please make sure you and your child sign the attached registration form as your child will not be approved to play the first game if the form is not signed by both student and parent. This form will be required to be signed and given to your coach on the first day of training.

## PLAYERS AGREEMENT

Players are expected to:

- 🏸 Honour your commitment to training and games each week.
- 🏸 In committing to playing you are committing to the team you are placed into for the duration of the season.
- 🏸 Placement into a team will not be on the basis of friendships and players will be expected to abide.
- 🏸 Training is compulsory; if you know that you will be unable to train you will need to accept that you may not play **"No Train No Game"**.
- 🏸 Appropriate behaviour is expected; you are representing your school. Those players found to be acting inappropriately towards others will be dealt with accordingly by the committee.
- 🏸 Players are to show respect to umpires, they are doing the best to their ability and sometimes this goes against you as a player, you need to deal with it appropriately. **"Respect the Role, Respect the Person"**.
- 🏸 You are expected to honour your financial commitment to the Netball Committee by having **registration completed and fees paid by Friday March 9<sup>th</sup> 2018**. Please email the committee should you require additional time to complete payment. No player will be allowed to play unless full payment has been made.
- 🏸 Late registration will not be accepted.
- 🏸 Non-refundable amount of \$110.00 on withdrawal of registration.

## NNA CODE OF CONDUCT

### **Participants who enter the Sue Belcher / Noranda Netball Association Complex**

- Will always play by the rules.
- Will never argue with an official. If there is a disagreement with a decision we will inform the captain, coach or manager during a break or after the competition.
- Will control our temper. We understand that verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport.
- Will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Will be a good sport and applaud all good plays whether they are made by my team or the opposition.
- Will treat all players in my sport as we like to be treated. We will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Will display modesty in victory and be gracious in defeat.
- Will not arrive at this venue intoxicated or drink alcohol or use drugs at the venue.

**NNA CONDITION OF ENTRY**

**By entering the Sue Belcher / Noranda Netball Association facility, all persons agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions.**

- **All persons** must conduct themselves in a proper and reasonable manner and in accordance with the Noranda Netball Association Codes of Conduct. A copy of which is available in the netball information book.
- By entering, all persons agree to be bound by the Noranda Netball Association’s constitution, rules and by-laws. Also, submit themselves to any Member Protection Tribunal and any other disciplinary forum connected with Netball.
- All types of cameras are prohibited in any change rooms.
- Parents, Spectators, Umpires and players entering agree to comply with any reasonable direction of any official connected with Noranda Netball Association
- The right to remove any person from this facility is reserved if the person’s behaviour is considered dangerous or unacceptable to the Noranda Netball Association.
- Any person using or under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs is prohibited from entering or remaining on these premises.
- Smoking is prohibited in any area of this facility and court area.
- We understand and accept that there are consequences if we break any one of the code of conduct rules.
