St Peters Dads (SPD) is pleased to present the 2018 Dads & Kids School Campout.

It will be held on the main oval and kindy playground of St Peter's School Bedford on Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 April.

This event is held with the support of The Fathering Project www.thefatheringproject.org and the St Peter's P&F Association.

The intent of the Campout is to provide an opportunity for Dads and Father Figures (Grandfather, Uncle etc.) to spend time with your kids in a safe and fun environment.

This special one-on-one time with dads and their kids helps improve the resilience, emotional intelligence (EQ) and interpersonal skills of the kids.

You and your kids will be able to spend time together setting up the tent, playing games, eating a barbecue dinner and watching a film in the undercover area.

You will also be able to meet other dads within the school community.

We want to encourage dads to socialise with each other, but the campout is a **NO ALCOHOL** event.

Primary age students from Kindy through to Year 6 from your family who attend St Peter's School or other schools to Year 6 are allowed to come along – they do not necessarily all have to be students at St Peter's School.

The behaviour and supervision of kids is the responsibility of the Dads and Father Figures. No child should be left unsupervised at any time.

We have created a Code of Conduct and request all dads who are attending the school campout to abide by and sign the Code of Conduct.
