- an understanding of identification strategies for placing students in the program;
- an excellent understanding of assessment and reporting;
- strategies and the need to provide effective and timely feedback to students and parents;
- evidence of relevant professional learning and involvement in professional activities in the GATe area;
- the capacity to be a proactive member of a professional learning community complying with the legal, administrative and professional requirements; and
- a preparedness to be fully involved in school activities.
