- highly effective communication and interpersonal skills so as to engage positively with colleagues, students and parents;
- excellent classroom management and organisational skills that create supportive and safe environments;
- an excellent understanding of a variety of assessment and reporting strategies and the need to provide effective and timely feedback to parents and students;
- the capacity to be a pro-active member of a professional learning community complying with the legal, administrative and professional requirements;
- a preparedness to be fully involved in school activities;
- accreditation to work in a Catholic School; and
