NAPLAN - The Year 3 and 5 students will participate in the National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy in the week commencing Monday, 8 May. NAPLAN tests provide point in time information in relation to student performance in Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Numeracy. There are always a number of contextual factors that will influence how well a student performs on a particular day in these tests. The results from NAPLAN tests are intended to complement the existing range of school based assessments and it is important that students are not overwhelmed by the experience or that the tests are given undue emphasis. The NAPLAN results assist in providing one part of the picture of your child's demonstrated learning. I ask that parents avoid any disruption of the Year 3 and 5 classes during the week NAPLAN tests are being conducted.

The Chisholm College Alumni will be hosting its annual VIP event at the college musical on Wednesday 17 May 2017.

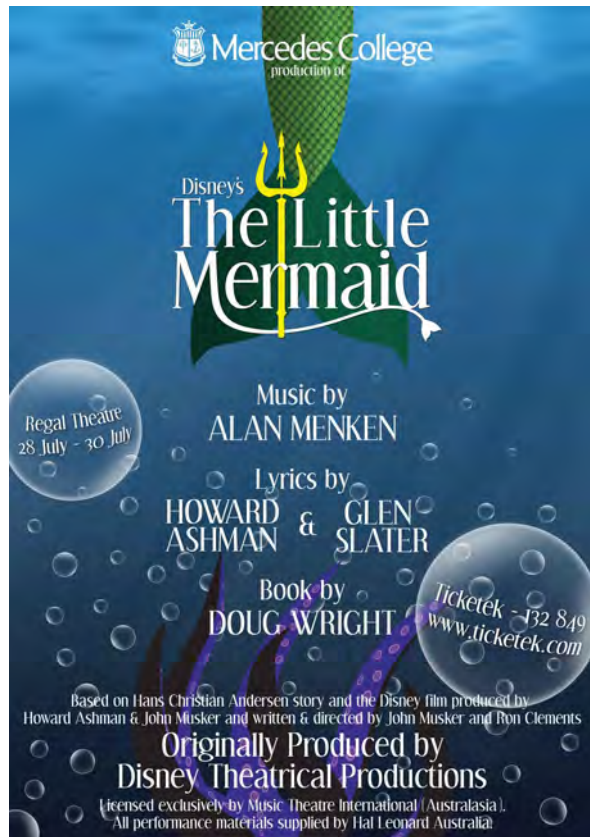
This year's show is Mary Poppins.

- **PROTECTIVE BEHAVIOUR WORKSHOP FOR PARENTS – TUESDAY, 30 MAY.** St Peter's P and F invites you to an internationally acclaimed personal safety program aiming to empower children, young people and adults with strategies to promote safety and resilience on **Tuesday 30 May 2017 at St Peter's Primary School from 7pm to 9:30pm** (undercover area).

The Protective Behaviours program teaches and promotes concepts of emotional literacy, empowerment, assertiveness, problem solving and an understanding of safety.

The Protective Behaviours program empowers people to:

- Assert their right to feel safe
- Recognise 'signs' their bodies give them when they may be unsafe
- Learn 'body safety' rules and safety strategies
- Understand the difference between safe and unsafe secrets
- Seek help from trusted people

This workshop is designed for parents, carers and grandparents to build their understanding of the 'grooming process', child sexual abuse and the Protective Behaviours program.
