**INSTALLATION MASS** - On Sunday at the 10am Mass, Father Jeronimo was formerly installed as the Parish Priest of St Peter's by the Most Reverend Donald Sproxtton, Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Perth. We have come to know Father Jeronimo in his role as the Priest in Charge of the St Peter's Parish in the last 11 months. We welcome his commitment to continue his work with us as the pastoral leader of our community for an extended period of time.

**BEFORE SCHOOL SUPERVISION** - A reminder to parents of students in Years 1-6 that supervision does not start at St Peter's until 8.15am each day. 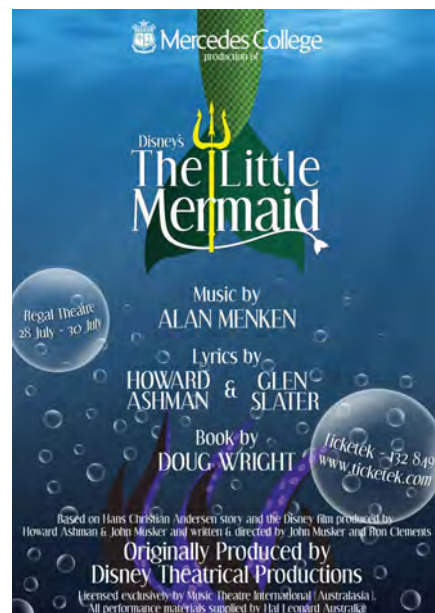


