

Dear Parents, Students and Staff,

**CONFIRMATION** - This year in the St Peter's Parish, Confirmation will be celebrated at the 6.00pm Mass on 27 May, the 10.00am Mass on 28 May and the 10.00am Mass on 11 June. While the ordinary minister of Confirmation is a Bishop; it is common, usual and valid that the faculty of conferring the Sacrament of Confirmation is granted to a Parish Priest. This year our confirmation candidates will receive Confirmation from Fr Jeronimo. Our Year 6 students complete their preparation to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation with a retreat on Tuesday. I ask the community to join me in praying that the Holy Spirit helps each of them grow in their relationship with God, to live in His influence and to use His gifts to direct and guide their decisions.

This is a special time for the children and their families and I wish everyone great joy and grace as they celebrate Confirmation.

The Protective Behaviours program presented by Justine O'Malley teaches and promotes concepts of emotional literacy, empowerment, assertiveness, problem solving and an understanding of safety. The Protective Behaviours program empowers kids to:

- Assert their right to feel safe
- Recognise 'signs' their bodies give them when they may be unsafe
- Learn 'body safety' rules and safety strategies
- Understand the difference between safe and unsafe secrets
- Seek help from trusted people

This workshop is designed for parents, carers and grandparents to build their understanding of the 'grooming process', child sexual abuse and the Protective Behaviours program.

Justine O'Malley BA(Ed), GradCertCPP, MSW is a qualified Teacher and Accredited Social Worker with over 20 years' experience working in the education and child protection sectors. Justine is one of Western Australia's pioneers in Protective Behaviours and served for 16 years on the board of Protective Behaviours Australia. She has taught Protective Behaviours to children, young people, parents and professionals across Australia and internationally.
