Dear Parents, Students and Staff,

CONFIRMATION - This year, Confirmation will be celebrated at the 6.00pm Mass on 9 June and the 10.00am Mass on 10 June. On Tuesday, Bishop Don Sproxton, who will preside at these celebrations, met with the Year 6 students who are in the final stages of their preparation to receive the sacrament. Bishop Don commented positively on the readiness of the Year 6 candidates to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and on the way they engaged in the review of their knowledge and understanding. I ask the community to join me in praying that the Holy Spirit helps each of them to grow in their relationship with God, to live in His influence and to use His gifts to guide and direct their decisions.

I acknowledge and express an appreciation to the following people for the parts they are playing in making the celebration a meaningful and special occasion:

- Chris Neville, the Sacrament Coordinator for the St Peter's Parish, who does an outstanding job of orchestrating the preparation program, conducting the workshops and communicating with families in the lead up to the celebrations.

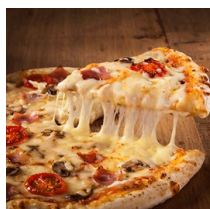
